Beautiful dark copper color, decent head. and a great aroma of malt with a slight hint of yeast. Liking the malt at the front with a nice finish at the back of the tongue with the hops.

Great balance. This is definitely a session beer in my opinion. By the way, that's the East Tx. spelling of beautiful."

"Wow! This is really fantastic. Pours a deep mahogany with very little head but decent lacing. My bottle says it was brewed on 2/04...oops. It really has held up beautifully though. The aroma is of raisins, caramel and brown sugar. Flavor is a molasses malt profile initially, more raisins, and toffee with a nice mild hoppy bite on the finish to keep it crisp. Everything is so clean and drinkable, yet very complex. The mouthfeel is substantial enough to feel slick on the palate, yet it is also very clean, crisp, and

In spite of how far my beer horizons have grown, I still find myself coming back to this one time and time again, partially out of sentiment, and that I think it's a tasty, easy drinking example style. For those situations where the proletariat demands a macro lager, this always comes through. In fact, we served this at my wedding.

One of the rare times I've poured it into a glass, this time into a nonic pint, it's a pale yellow with a thin white head that quickly fades to a steady skim, fed by the steady streamers.

The aroma is moderate, raw grain, leafy hops, and

The taste is also grainy and skunky, a bit of bread dough as well, with a dry, bitter, crisp noble hop finish.

The mouthfeel is crisp and the body is very light. It seems a little watery out of the glass, but I never notice this out of the bottle.

Since I like this beer, I can drink it like water. My go to cheap hot drink a lot brew, it never lets me down...while I recognize that I drank their kool-aide, it's pretty good. Indeed, some girls are unforgettable!"

"Despite the cheesy advertisements, this is a good German lager. Unlike a lot of other lagers in this category here, this one is distinctly German. The German lagers tend to have a bit of sourness that sits on the center of the tongue, which this one definitely has.

St. Pauli Girl's color is a golden-yellow, and pours with a bit of a head. Carbonation is mild. Aroma is pretty clean, but you can sense the grain.

Overall, a quality German lager, but you'll probably either like or hate the style."
